




## Get folding, get thoughtful.

Follow these simple (we promise) instructions to fold your envelope.

### Step 1

Position sheet of paper with #thisisthoughtful sitting at the top, then turn over to the blank side.


Fold in half on the vertical axis, crease well and unfold.



### Step 2


(a) Fold both the left and right sides on the diagonal to meet in the centre fold.

(b) Then fold both sides again to meet the centre fold.




### Step 3

Fold the bottom diamond shape in half, make a crease, and then unfold.




### Step 4

Now pry apart the two sides of the diamond shape (a), creating an opening (b) and flatten to form a rectangle over the previous folds (c).




### Step 5

Make two small folds inwards toward the centre.




### Step 6

Now fold down the top and make a crease.




### Step 7

Insert the top flap (a) into the opening you made in Step 4 (b) (This will keep the penny from falling out. Now would be a good time to put in your penny.)



### Step 8

Now fold the envelope in half, making sure the cover is on the outside and rotate (obviously).
